What We Do

- The Siksikaitsitapi Agriculture Project focused on supporting Blackfoot-led food systems, land stewardship, and knowledge sharing.
- Our communications & education tools, including:
 - **Farmer's Blog & Podcast** storytelling platforms that highlight producers leading the way in regenerative agriculture.
 - Workshops, events, and field days interactive opportunities for rural Albertans to learn from one another and share practical insights.
